# Festival Planches 2025 FESTIVAL REGULATIONS

# as part of an Blended Intensive Program : Planches, the international student festival of performing arts (Erasmus BIP)

# Purpose of the festival

The international student performing arts festival *Planches* will take place from Monday May 19 to Saturday May 24, 2025. It aims to promote the work of performing arts students and to celebrate the cultural and linguistic diversity, dear to Bordeaux Montaigne University.

The festival will welcome eight student troupes. It is organized by the Culture Department of Bordeaux Montaigne University and receives the support of the Languages and Civilizations Department.

## Conditions of participation

The composition of the troupe must respect the following criteria:

- be composed of a minimum of five students from the same university and a maximum of ten members from the same university
- optional: be accompanied by a maximum of one teacher

The troupe must designate a privileged contact among students who will answer the questions regarding the artistic proposition.

The artistic proposition must meet the following criteria:

- belong to the performing arts: theater, dance, performance, manipulation of objects and puppets, body percussion, etc.
- be interpreted in native and/or foreign language
- be accompanied by a comprehension tool (sub or surtitling, detailed room sheet, etc.) in English and French
- have a duration of 1h15 maximum
- be able to adapt to the performance venue that will be assigned to it

### Terms of participation

The troupe commits to:

- provide visuals and presentation texts which will be used on the website and the program,
   specifying the list of participants and their role in the artistic proposition
- provide the technical sheets and light plans necessary for the technical installation
- adapt to performance venues (the technical sheet of the venue will be send later)
- return the form "Cessation of rights to the image" signed by each of its members
- be present (or send a representative) to the various online and face-to-face meetings necessary for the organization of the festival
- be present (or send a representative) to the various remote and face-to-face appointments necessary for the organization of the festival
- be present for the entire duration of the festival (arrival on May 19 and departure on May 24)

Sending an application to the festival constitutes an act of acceptance to the conditions of these regulations by each member of the troupe.

Number of ECTS Credits contracted : 3 ECTS credits will be awarded to students who have completed the program.

#### Calendar and schedule

Component Timing (Students will need to attend online meeting to prepare for the festival):

- o Session 1: Presentation of the festival (1 virtual session between February 3<sup>rd</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> exact date to be confirmed)
- o Session 2: Presentation of the shows (2 virtual sessions between March 10<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup> exact dates to be confirmed)
- o Session 3: Technical meeting: (1 virtual session between April 21<sup>st</sup> and May 9<sup>th</sup> exact date to be confirmed)

#### Planches Festival

Physical mobility start date: May 19<sup>th</sup>; physical end date: May 24<sup>th</sup>:

- Reception of the troupes and welcoming cocktail: May 19
- Rehearsals during the day and performances in the evening: May 20 to 23
- The troupe will have a half-day slot in the appointed venue, which will serve as rehearsal and technical calibration.
- Departure of the troupes: May 24 Virtual

#### Support arrangements

The Culture Department of Bordeaux Montaigne University plans and takes care of:

- accommodation for the troupe and the teacher during the festival (from May 19 to 24, 2025)
- breakfasts and evening meals
- transport in the city during the duration of the festival

The Culture Department of Bordeaux Montaigne University does not plan and does not support:

- transport from the city of origin to Bordeaux
- lunches
- the purchase, rental and/or delivery of decor
- the purchase, rental and/or delivery of technical equipment additional to that already present in the venue

Students can apply for Erasmus+ funding from their home institution, under the reference: BIP 2023-1-FR01-KA131-HED-000133099-1 Planches , the international student festival of performing arts

#### **Application**

- Call for nominations by universities: Until January 19th. The application file must necessarily include:
  - Fill the nomination form and add the annex 1 and the regulations signed Nominate your students here:

- Call for application (by nominated students): Until January 31<sup>st</sup>. Once the nominations have been processed by Student Mobility Office (IRO) of Bordeaux Montaigne University, students receive an email with the login details that are required for the online application

In the event of responses to the call for participation greater than the number of places, a selection will be made on the basis of the artistic project presented.
